Orsi Trying to Derail Legal Proceedings: CBI

Former Finmeccanica chief appearing through lawyers since December 2019, says probe agency

New Delhi: The Central Bureau of Investigation has alleged that former Finmeccanica chief executive Giuseppe Orsi was trying to "swear" further legal proceedings as the alleged 5,000 crore VVIP helicopter purchase scam.

In a response to Orsi's petition challenging the special CBI Court's jurisdiction to try him in the case, the CBI alleged that Orsi was trying to "misuse the intricacies of law".

Orsi, an Italian national, is accused in the case filed by the CBI. The Indian Air Force had struck a deal to buy helicopters from Augusta Westland, which was a UK subsidiary of Finmeccanica (now renamed Leonardo), during the VVIP regime.

In his petition Orsi sought suspension of proceedings saying that the summons served to him by the agency were "unlawful". Raising the plea of double jeopardy, Orsi submitted that in any event, no offence was made out against him since he already was acquitted by an Italian court in 2016.

Seeking dismissal of his petition, the CBI said Orsi had been participating in the court proceedings through his lawyers from December 18, 2019 and "has only now chosen to prefer an application for vague and ambiguous relief, when the matter is being progressed expeditiously".

Responding to the plea of double jeopardy, the CBI said that agreement "is liable to be discarded in line with the internationally recognised principle of dual sovereignty which provides for separate prosecutions for an offence punishable under separate sovereigns".

The agency alleged that Orsi's plea was only to "delay and derail the proceedings" before the special CBI court. The agency said the service of summons upon Orsi is "complete", "assessing of summons is for the purpose of notifying the person of his legal obligation to appear before the court as a response to violation of law... and the essential criteria is duly satisfied in the instant case," it said.

The agency submitted that it was not that Orsi never received summons of the special CBI court or was unaware of the criminal proceedings against him. Elaborating, it added that "on becoming aware of the proceedings", Orsi authorised his lawyers for his representation, and they have been appearing on his behalf from December 18, 2019.

Sufficient Material Against 2 Ex-Judges to Proceed: Court

Retired high court judges charged with corruption

New Delhi: Taking cognisance of a charge sheet filed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) against two former High Court judges on charges of corruption in a Medical College bribery scandal, a special Court has summoned the two retired judges and other accused later this month.


"Examination of the record reflects that sufficient material is available against accused persons to proceed ahead", the special CBI Court held earlier this week summoning Justices (retd) SN Shukla of Allahabad and DM Goudal of Orissa. Besides the two former judges, four other accused have been summoned by the Court.

The court has taken cognisance of charges of criminal conspiracy and corruption under relevant sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act slapped by the CBI against the two former judges and the co-accused.

"The case is also based on illegal phone tapping breach of the right of privacy and is going to fall flat like the previous case where CBI has been asked to provide the entire record of review committee in terms of the Telegraph Act. The CBI has not been able to provide the same", defence counsel Vijay Agarwal told ET.

In Madhya Pradesh, there has been no cabinet expansion in the government for 17 days now. The Shinde government has indicated that it would have a cabinet expansion after the July 21 Presidential polls. Sources said that the cabinet expansion may take place on June 21. The gap of 17 days has ticked the Shiv Sena, with Rajinikanth MP and party spokesperson of the Sena (Uddhav group) asking Governor BS Keshari to intervene seeking the imposition of President's rule in the state.

Rebel Sena leader Eknath Shinde was sworn in as Maharashtra's chief minister on June 30 along with BJP leader Devendra Fadnis as deputy chief minister and there has been no cabinet expansion in the government for 17 days now.
