RS elections generate heat, legislators coming today

Both parties active to stop horse trading

The Rajya Sabha election to be held on June 19 has generated a lot of political heat. Both BJP and Congress called their respective legislators to the state capital on Wednesday.

The Congress is going to hold meetings of its lawmakers at the residence of former chief minister Kamal Nath on June 17 and 18.

State in charge of the party Mukul Wasink will also attend the meetings. He will visit the state for the first time after becoming the in charge of party's state unit.

The BJP, too, has called their legislators to Bhopal. The party will hold a meeting of its legislators on Wednesday. Party's state in charge Vinay Shashrabuddhe and Union Minister Prakash Javadekar are also arriving in the city. BJP legislators will meet in their presence.



According to the number of legislators of each party in the House, the BJP should get two seats and the Congress one. BSP, SP and Independent legislators have yet to open their cards.

Fifty-two votes are required to elect an RS member. The BJP has 107 members in the House. The party is all set to get two seats.

On the other hand, the Congress has 92 members, and it will need 12 members more to win two seats.

BSP, SP and Independent legislators had been with the Congress government. Former chief ministers Digvijaya Singh and Kamal Nath are pulling out all the stops to keep those legislators with the Congress.

For five votes, the Congress is sparing no effort to make a dent in the walls of the BJP and woo its legislators.

Two BJP legislators Narayan Tripathi and Sharad Kol had once supported the Congress, so the party is trying to cotton up to them again.

The problem with these

legislators is that if they violate the party whip they will lose their membership.

The BJP is also trying to keep its flock together. Home minister Narottam Mishra has been asked to deal with the BSP, SP and Independent legislators that they may vote in favour of the BJP.

Senior BJP leaders are also in contact with the party MLAs so that they may not vote for the Congress.

Mishra said all the legislators would remain at the places where they generally stay.

All of them will stay in their residences, Mishra said, adding that, the BJP would easily win two seats. According to general secretary of the Congress Rajiv Singh, a two-day meeting of party legislators will be held, and that they have been told to stay the way they want. Singh said the party was fully prepared to fight the RS election.

Loan waiver puts Apex Bank on verge of collapse

GOVT NEEDS TO GIVE RS 792 CR TO BANK

State-owned Apex Bank is on the verge of collapse because of Congress government's farm loan waiver scheme.

To waive off loans of farmers, the previous Congress government disbursed loans of co-operative banks through Apex Bank.

The Congress government may have waived off loans through the bank but it did not transfer the money to financial institution. The loan waived off in second phase was Rs 792 crore. The bank is facing problem because this sum was not

transferred to it. The co-operatives department has been demanding money from state finance department but received no response.

Apex Bank earned profit of Rs 28 crore in 2018-19. This year's balance sheet is being prepared. If the bank does not get back money, the financial institution will be in trouble.

The bank management is planning to debit the amount deposited to farmers' accounts if the government does not give the money. The bank may also take money back from

farmers.

The Apex Bank management has refused to say anything on the matter. The Congress claims that it has waived off loans worth Rs 6,000 crore, which belongs to nationalised and co-operative banks.

The nationalised banks began loan waiving process after taking money from the government. But the co-operative bank may incur a huge loss.

In the first phase of loan waiver and later, the government gave part of money to co-operative banks and societies. As the Con-

gress government is no longer in power, it may be difficult for bank to get back money.

When Congress launched loan waiving scheme, it was feared that it would affect co-operatives sector financially.

After the change of government and after the economic slowdown because of the corona pandemic, the finance department would find it difficult to pay the amount.

Agriculture minister Kamal Patel said Congress deceived farmers in the name of loan waiver. Patel said an FIR would be lodged against former chief minister Kamal Nath.

Scindia discharged from hospital

BHOPAL: Former MP Jyotiraditya Scindia who tested positive for covid-19 was discharged from hospital and returned to his home on Tuesday.



Nevertheless, his mother also tested for the disease is still in the hospital. RS election will be held on June 19 and BJP has nominated Scindia. Chances of his being present in Bhopal on the election day are very thin. According to covid-19 protocol, after being discharged from hospital, a patient has to stay in home quarantine for 14 days. Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan expressed happiness over Scindia's speedy recovery.

12 jawans of 17th Battalion, one CRPF personnel infected with corona

After policemen, now jawans of battalions in bulk have been infected with COVID-19 while discharging their duty in city.

Twelve jawans of 17th Battalion were reported corona positive on Tuesday. The Jawans were deployed in Banganga slums after coronavirus took into its grip the area. With 47 positives cases reported on Tuesday, the city patient count on Tuesday stands at 2423. So far 74 deaths have been reported in the capital.

Earlier, the police personnel had infected with virus after they coming in contact with Jamatis in Mosque. Similarly, after Banganga was declared a hotspot, the jawans were deployed in the area to ensure compliance of the physical distancing and also to provide security to medicos. The services of jawans were also taken in shifting the corona suspects to quarantine centre. Besides, five cases came from Kotwali areas.

One jawan was tested positive for corona from CRPF Bangrasia, with this the number of personnel contacting the infection has gone to three. Five halls and barracks have been vacated

and converted into quarantine centre. Earlier, the two were admitted to AIIMS, one after being cured and another is recuperating. SDM Rajesh Gupta said, the jawans were deployed in Banganga slums while on duty contacted the infection. "These jawans of 17th Battalion were housed in a dharamshala at Aishbag and not allowed to visit their home keeping in mind the safety of their families from the infection." However, now they have fallen sick and hospitalized, informed the SDM, adding that five of them were admitted to Pt. Khushilal Sharma Govt. (Autonomous) Ayurveda College and Institute, Bhopal. Seven jawans were admitted to seven have

been admitted to Chirayu Hospital. Besides, the CRPF men, three more call centre employees handling 108 ambulance service at C-21 Mall have been reported positive. One case was reported from Bharat Nagar where a man has been diagnosed with the infection. Four days ago, his elder brother had contacted corona.

Digvijaya Singh to file FIR against CM

BHOPAL: As the police crime branch has registered a case against former chief minister Digvijaya Singh, the latter plans to file FIR against chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan who had tweeted a fake and edited video of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi. It was alleged that Singh has re-tweeted the edited video of chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan through his twitter account. The crime branch has registered case in this regard. Additional superintendent of police

Nishchal Jharia told Free Press that police are looking into account details of Digvijaya Singh and others from twitter, a social media platform company. "Action will be taken as details arrive," he added. On Tuesday, Digvijaya Singh said he will lodge a complaint at same police station where his case had been registered. He said CM Chouhan had shared the fake edited video of the then AICC national president Rahul Gandhi a year back.
