

We'll know how good we are at Asiad: Nieva

Indian boxers will know their global standing from their Asian Games show, High Performance Director Santiago Nieva said today and reckoned the draw could play a crucial role in how well the pugilists perform in Jakarta. Seven men and three women pugilists were given an official send-off by the Boxing Federation of India (BFI) and Sports India ahead of their flight for Jakarta Wednesday.

"Now we will know how good we are. This will be the test and we will know where we stand because some really strong countries will be there," Nieva said. The boxers had accounted for five medals — one gold and four bronze — in the 2014 edition in Incheon, South Korea. This was way lower than their best ever per-



formance which came in 2010, when the boxers bagged 2 gold, 3 silver and 4 bronze medals in all. "The draw is going to be big and it will be certainly a factor. But we have grown enough to ensure that it is not a big factor. But this is not going to be that easy," he said. "We will know where we

stand on the world stage and how we are going to do in the world championships next year," he added. The view was seconded by BFI President Ajay Singh, who reminded the gathering that powerhouse Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan are going to be there. "Don't forget that, it is not the

Commonwealth Games. The big countries are going to be there," he said. "But I nonetheless expect every boxer to come back with a medal, just like the Commonwealth Games, and make it our best ever performance," he added. The touch of pragmatism could not take away the confidence with two-

time medallist Vikas Krishan (75kg) — a gold winner in 2010 and bronze medallist in 2014 — declaring that this was the "most perfect team" heading to the Games. His confidence is not misplaced. The team boasts of four world championships medallists — Vikas and Shiva Thapa (60kg) among men and Sarjubala Devi (51kg) and Sonia Iather (57kg) — among women. Vikas had also claimed a gold at the Commonwealth Games earlier this year.

The medallists from this year's Commonwealth Games in the team include Amit Panghal (49kg), Gaurav Solanki (52kg) and Manoj Kumar (69kg). The boxing competition at the Asiad is scheduled to start from August 24 and the Indians are leaving slightly a week in advance to get themselves acclimatised with the conditions.

Gameiro vows to score 20 goals for Valencia

Forward Kevin Gameiro said during his presentation as a Valencia CF player that he expects to score at least 20 goals this season and to help his new team finish higher than former club Atletico Madrid. "For six years I have won a title at the end of each season and I hope to do that at Valencia CF," the French international said here on Monday, reports EFE news agency.

Gameiro won Ligue 1 with Paris Saint-Germain and three successive Europa League titles with Sevilla before joining Atletico, where he was part of a squad that finished second in the Champions League in 2016-2017 and hoisted the 2017-2018 Europa League trophy in May. Atleti sent the Frenchman to Valencia for a transfer fee of 16 million euros (18



million). Gameiro said he was looking forward to facing his old team in the Aug. 20 La Liga opener between Valencia and

Atletico. Atletico finished second to Barcelona last season, while Valencia were fourth. Acknowledging that he was no longer young, the 31-year-old Gameiro stressed his fitness and his experience in both domestic and European competitions. "I hope to contribute my experience, my pace, and that all of that is good for the group," he said with his wife and children at his side.

Eto'o signs for Qatar league side

Veteran Cameroon star Samuel Eto'o has signed for Qatar league side, Qatar Sports Club, it was announced, just days after he ended a brief stay at Turkish side Konyaspor. The former Barcelona, Inter Milan and Chelsea striker will be unveiled on Tuesday, said Qatar Sports Club, the latest big-name edition to Qatar's domestic league as it gears up to host the 2022 World Cup. The club said on social media that it would "present the international star Samuel Eto'o" at a press conference. It is understood he underwent a medical earlier in the day.



The four-time African player of the year will join former colleagues in Qatar, including ex-Barcelona teammate Xavi Hernandez, who plays for Al Sadd, and Wesley Sneijder who was at Inter with Eto'o. In 2009, Eto'o won the Champions League with Barcelona playing alongside Xavi. A year later he won the same trophy with Inter in the same team as Sneijder. The Dutchman now plays for Al

Gharafa in Qatar's domestic competition, the Qatar Stars League. The signing is a coup for Qatar Sports Club, who finished in mid-table last season and currently have little hope of winning any domestic titles.

Earlier on Monday Eto'o said Ligue 1 clubs had contacted him after he announced he was leaving Turkey last week. The 37-year-old is now in the twilight of a fabulous career. He en-

joyed five hugely successful seasons with Barcelona from 2004 to 2009, before helping Jose Mourinho's Inter team to win the treble of Champions League, Serie A and Coppa Italia titles in his first season in Italy. He then had brief stints at Chelsea and Everton in the Premier League. Eto'o also scored 56 times for his country in 118 appearances and won two African Cup of Nations with Cameroon.

Women's handball team suffers defeat to Kazakhstan in opening match

The Indian women's handball team began its Asian Games campaign on a losing note as it suffered a 19-36 defeat to Kazakhstan in their preliminary round match here Tuesday. The Indian team gave a tough fight in the first period, trailing 13-19 but was out-

played 6-17 by its opponents in the second period of the Group A match.

For India, Rimpi was the highest scorer with eight goals from just nine shots while Maninder Kaur netted three. Nidhi Sharma and Ritu scored two goals each. For Kazakhstan, Dana Abilda scored eight goals while Olga Tankita

got six. The difference in class between the two sides was evident as Kazakhstan got as many as 54 shots at goals as against 36 for India. India will next play Korea in their second group match on August 16. The Indian men's handball team had lost to Chinese Taipei 28-38 in its first group match yesterday.

Asian Games gold medalist athlete Hakam Singh today passed away at a private hospital in Sangrur, Punjab. He had been ailing for some time and was undergoing treatment for liver and kidney ailments. He was 64. Singh won gold in 20 km race walk event during the 1978 Asiad at Bangkok. The Dhyam Chand awardee had also served as Havaladar in the 6 Sikh regiment. Union Sports Minister Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore had sanctioned financial assis-



tance of Rs 10 lakh to the athlete, while Punjab Chief Minister Capt. Amarinder Singh helped him with Rs 5 lakh. Punjab Sports and Youth Affairs Minister Rana Gurmit Singh Sodhi expressed profound grief over the demise of Singh. Condoling the demise of

the athlete, Rana Sodhi said that both Punjab as well as the country would remember the glorious achievements of Singh in the sporting arena. He termed the passing away of Singh as end of an era and an irreparable loss to the sports fraternity.
