# SP-BSP alliance will knock out BJP in LS polls, says Akhilesh

Samajwadi Party (SP) chief Akhilesh Yadav on Friday said an alliance between his party and the Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) will knock out the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in the 2019 Lok Sabha polls. Addressing a ‘chaupal’ in Kannauj, the Lok Sabha constituency of his wife Dimple Yadav, the former Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister said that the writing was on the wall for the BJP.

He pointed out how the coming together of the SP and BSP even in an informal way had ensured that the BJP lost seats held by UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and his deputy Keshav Prasad Maurya. With BSP extending its support to the SP candidates in Phulpur and Gorakhpur, BJP candidates lost in both the parliamentary by-polls in 2018, leaving the ruling party red-faced.

“This time too our arithmetic is in place and we will ensure that the BJP loses at the hustings,” the 45-year-old said. He, however forewarned the people to be on guard against what he termed was the “rumour spreading machinery” of the BJP.

Yadav added that for the state and the country to progress, one should shrug off caste and community affiliations and work for development. He accused the BJP government led by Adityanath of trying to mislead the people.

Talking about the reported prospects of the CBI questioning him with regards to allocation of

mines during his stint as the state’s Mining and Chief Minister, Yadav said whatever the CBI had to ask to him should be after the Lok Sabha elections. He tweaked his party’s election credo ‘Kaam Bolta hai’ (Our work speaks) to “Hamara Kaam bolta hai, Bhaipa ka Dhoka bolta hai” (Our work speaks, BJP’s deceit speaks).

## IGNORING US IN UP WILL BE DANGEROUS MISTAKE: CONGRESS

**NEW DELHI:** Giving out a stern message to the Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) and the Samajwadi Party (SP), which are likely to announce their alliance for the Lok Sabha polls, the Congress on Friday said ignoring the grand old party will be a “dangerous mistake”. Reacting to BSP supremo Mayawati and SP chief Akhilesh Yadav’s joint press conference to be held in Uttar Pradesh’s capital Lucknow today, Congress spokesperson Abhishek Manu Singhvi here said it is the responsibility of the opposition parties to synergize their efforts to uproot the Narendra Modi-led Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government. “The objective of all such parties including the SP and the BSP is similar and clear to try and eliminate this kind of autocratic and absolute mis-governance, to remove such people from the electoral map.

## HC grants bail to Gohain, Gogoi, Mahanta

The Guwahati High Court on Friday granted bail to senior journalist Manjit Mahanta and interim relief to Assamese litterateur Hiren Gohain and KMSS leader Akhil Gogoi in a sedition case filed by Assam Police for their alleged remarks against the citizenship bill. Justice H K Sarma granted interim bail to Gohain and Gogoi, RTI activist and chief of the Krishak Mukti Sangram Samiti (KMSS), against a surety of Rs 5,000 each.

The Judge also directed police to file the case diary by January 22. Mahanta was granted absolute bail as there is no specific allegation against him in the FIR. Police had filed a suo motu case under Indian Penal Code sections, including 121, 123 and 124(A) (sedition), at the Latalil police station here.

## Jaiswal, OP Singh, Modi front runners in CBI chief hunt

**NEW DELHI:** A day after Alok Verma was ousted as the CBI Director, the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) has expedited its exercise to shortlist the final names from among some 10 Director General level IPS officers for the agency’s top post, people familiar with the matter said.

The list included the names of senior Indian Police Service (IPS) officers selected in 1983, 1984 and 1985. Leading the race are Mumbai Police Commissioner Subodh Kumar Jaiswal, a 1985-batch IPS officer, Uttar Pradesh Director General of Police O.P. Singh and National Investigation Agency (NIA) chief Y.C. Modi, informed sources said.

After the DoPT chooses the names of at least three or four officers for the CBI Director’s post, they would be sent to the Select Commit-

tee comprising the Prime Minister, the Chief Justice of India and the Leader of Congress in the Lok Sabha to decide the final pick for a fixed term of two years.

As Verma’s tenure was to end on January 31, the final decision is expected to be announced before or within the last week of this month. A Home Ministry official who asked not to be named said a list of 17 officers had sent to DoPT in December 2018 for selection as CBI Director.

Another officer, seeking anonymity, told IANS that the DoPT was in the process of shortlisting the names of officers on the basis of matters such as experience in investigating anti-corruption cases, prior experience of working in CBI, handling vigilance matters in cadre and integrity.

### ‘Treat me deemed...

Verma, a 1979-batch IPS officer from AG-MUT cadre, was transferred from the position of CBI director to DG, Fire Service, Civil Defence and Home Guards under the Home Ministry on Thursday. “Natural justice was scuttled and the entire process was turned upside down in ensuring that the undersigned is removed from the post of the director CBI. The selection committee did not consider the fact that the entire CVC report is premised on charges alluded by a complainant who is at present under investigation by the CBI,” Verma said in a veiled reference to Special Director Rakesh Asthana. He said it may be noted that the CVC only forwarded a purportedly signed statement of the complainant (Asthana), and the complainant never came before Justice (Retd) A K Patnaik who is supervising the enquiry.

“Also, Justice Patnaik has concluded that the findings and conclusions of the report are not his,” the 61-year-old said.

He said institutions are one of the strongest and most visible symbols of the democracy and it was no exaggeration that the CBI is one of the most important organisations in India today.

“The decisions made yesterday will not just be a reflection on my functioning but will become a testimony on how the CBI as an institution will be treated by any government through the CVC, who is appointed by majority members of the ruling government. This is a moment for collective introspection to state the least,” he said. The former Delhi police commissioner said he is a career bureaucrat and it is the idea of his integrity that has been the driving force for four decades in public service. “Also, it may be noted that the undersigned would have already superannuated as on July 31, 2017 and was only serving the government as director, CBI till January 31, 2019 as the same was a fixed tenure role. The undersigned is no longer director, CBI and has already crossed his superannuation age for DG, Fire Services, Civil Defence and Home Guards.

### Will ban CBI...

In case of ban, raids in fresh cases too would require sanction from the state concerned or else from high court or Supreme Court. The ban would not be applicable on cases handed over to the agency by HC or SC. The ban would not be applicable on existing cases and central government matters within a state, such as cases against senior central government bureaucrats or a central PSU under the Prevention of Corruption Act.

### CM assures probe...

Congress, media committee, president, Shobha Oza too has demanded detailed investigations into the anomalies pointed in the report. Congress would bring the corruption of previous government into the knowledge of people, she added. Meanwhile, BJP spokesman Rajneesh Agarwal, said that CAG report was a document related to accounts. Stating the ruling Con-

gress was making unnecessary issue over it, Agarwal said that after the tabling of the report in the Assembly due process should be followed.

**Cong may also keep PAC chairman post:** After getting its member elected to the post of deputy speaker in state assembly, the Congress may also keep the post of chairman of Public Accounts Committee (PAC). The CAG report after being tabled in the House goes to the PAC. Congress, in order to make CAG report a big issue and use it against the previous government, would want its own MLA as PAC chairman, who is appointed by assembly speaker.

### Govind Singh is...

Minister Prabhuram Choudhary has been assigned Damoh and Panna districts and Priavrat Singh of Jabalpur and Katni districts. Umang Singar will be in-charge minister of Gwalior, Jaivardhan Singh of Rajgarh and Agar-Malwa while Kamleshwar Patel of Balaghat and Betul districts. Minister Lakhnan Ghangoria has been assigned Satna and Rewa districts, Mahendra Singh Sisodia Ashoknagar, Minister Pradummn Singh Tomar Shivपुरi, minister Sachin Yadav is the in-charge minister of Ratlam, minister Surendra Singh Baghel is having the responsibilities of Jhabua and Alirajpur. Tulsi Silawat has been made incharge of Khandwa and Burhanpur.

### Woman trial court...

During the hearing on Friday before a bench of Justices A K Sikri and S Abdul Nazeer, senior advocate Indira Jaising, appearing for the petitioner, said that response of the high court was on record now.

However, the counsel appearing for state of Madhya Pradesh said they needed a week time to file their response. “You should have filed your reply by now,” the bench told the state’s counsel. Later, the court asked the state to file its response and posted the matter for final disposal after two weeks.

In her plea, the petitioner has said that her fundamental rights granted under the Constitution for employment, to work and to carry on her profession needs to be secured. She has said that the HC had ignored the categorical finding in the report of the Judges Inquiry Committee dated December 15, 2017 terming the petitioner’s resignation dated July 15, 2014 from her post of Additional District Judge as “unbearable circumstances having no other option”.

### I-T raids on Saraogi...

Saraogi was made main accused in the hawala scam of Rs 2500 crore in December 2017. SP Katni Gaurav Tiwari, who exposed the scam, was transferred after a month. Name of the then minister and mining baron Sanjay Pathak also came to light for his relations with Saraogi.

Sources said that the documents seized during the raids may lead to a national hawala scam with its roots in foreign countries. The raids were on till filing of this report.

## Tourism ministry sanctions projects worth Rs 190 crore

**NEW DELHI:** The tourism ministry has sanctioned projects worth Rs 190 crore for development of spiritual circuits in Meghalaya and Uttar Pradesh, it said in a statement on Friday. Through this project, the ministry will be developing facilities such as festival grounds, tourist facilitation centre, last mile connectivity, public conveniences, cable suspension bridge, cafeteria, trekking routes, boating facilities, illumination, solid waste management, drinking water facility, caving facilities, visitor centres, adventure sports activities, craft haats in the state.

# SC nod to construction of projects under Chardham development plan

The Supreme Court on Friday lifted its stay on certain stalled projects under the government’s ambitious Chardham development plan, which proposes to provide all-weather connectivity to the four holy towns of Uttarakhand.

The court said the stay will however continue on those projects which are yet to begin under the plan till the environment clearance is taken by the authorities. The four towns of the hilly state to be connected by all-weather roads are Yamnotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath.

The top court also stayed a paragraph in the National Green Tribunal (NGT) order passed on September 26 last year which said that these projects did not require Environmental Im-

pact Assessment Approval/Environment Clearance in terms of the notification of Ministry of Environment & Forests.

On October 22 last year, the apex court had stayed the NGT order clearing the entire ambitious Chardham project in Uttarakhand. A bench of Justices R F Nariman and Vineet Sharan said that ongoing projects will not be stayed and the projects which have not yet taken off will be stayed. It said that in case of stalled projects the authorities will follow the usual drill and seek the requisite environmental clearances.

The paragraph 46 of the NGT order of September 26 will be stayed, the bench said. The paragraph said: “Accordingly, these projects did not require EIA Approval/Environment Clearance in terms of the Notification of MoEF&CC

dated September 14, 2006 and amended on August 22, 2013 vide S.O. 2559 (E)”.

The bench also asked Additional Solicitor General Pinky Anand appearing for the Centre to file an affidavit in eight weeks on the number of ongoing projects. At the outset, Anand along with advocate Balendu Shekhar said that NGT has cleared the project and all due procedure were followed.

He said that seven land-slides have taken place due to the ecologically fragile nature of the hills which are being cut almost vertically.

Parikh, appearing for the petitioner, NGO Citizens for Green Doon, had said that if the project was allowed to go on, an irreversible damage would be done to the ecology which would be equal to damage done by 10 hydro power projects.
