# CM holds urgent meet on urea supply, orders FIR against guilty

Chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan called an urgent meeting on irregularities committed in urea supply in Jabalpur and ordered officials to take stern action while lodging an FIR against the guilty, as per officials.

More than 890 tons of urea worth over Rs 3 crore, which was meant for supply to farmers didn't reach co-operative societies in Jabalpur, Mandla, Dindori, Damoh and Seoni.

Holding a meeting at 7 am from CM House on Friday, Chouhan said those who deprived farmers of fertilisers would not be spared. "It is a serious crime specially when there

**Bhopal:** An FIR was lodged at Lordganj police station in Jabalpur by district marketing officer Rohit Singh Baghel against Krishak Bharati Cooperative (KRIBHCO) Ltd marketing director Rajendra Chaudhary, Dwarka Gupta of Transporter DPMK Fertiliser, Jaiprakash Singh, state manager of Rack Handler and others under Sections 3 and 7 of Essential Commodities Act and under Sections 409, 34 and 120-B of IPC. After the CM's instructions, the officials of Jabalpur Agriculture Department and Marketing Federation inspected Gayatri Warehouse located at village Archha Benikheda and Laxmi Warehouse located at Khajri Khiria and took action.

is a need for fertilisers," he remarked.

He ordered strict action against culprits. Jabalpur divisional commissioner B Chandrasekar apprised chief minister of district-wise allocation of urea in Jabalpur division and said

KRIBHCO was supposed to supply urea through private transporters to various districts. The urea was transported from August 28 to 31. However, urea was supplied in less quantity at certain places and not supplied at

other places. It was supplied at many private places.

On August 25, 2600 metric tons of urea arrived in Jabalpur. KRIBHCO was informed about area-wise supply and given a list. He said fertiliser movement control order was violated by diverting the fertilisers.

During interaction, Chouhan said farmers should not face any problem in getting fertilisers anywhere in the state as there was adequate allocation of fertilisers for Madhya Pradesh. A close watch should be kept on the supply of fertilisers to farmers, he said.

He instructed the officials to initiate criminal proceedings against the guilty immediately.

## 1,000 dogs near Kuno get anti-rabies shots

**Bhopal:** More than 1,000 dogs have been given anti-rabies vaccine doses around Kuno National Park where cheetahs are being brought from Africa. The move is aimed at protecting the cheetahs from rabies. KNP's Divisional Forest Officer PK Verma said, "Usually, a leopard kills an animal and after devouring a portion of the carcass it leaves the remaining part only to return to eat the leftovers later after feeling hungry. In the mean time, if a rabid dog eats that leopard prey's leftover, the big cat is bound to catch rabies and spread it among other wild animals in the forest."

In 2013, a rabid dog had bitten the tail of a three-year-old tiger in Panna Tiger Reserve, which was given anti-rabies shot. PTI

## Bharti cancels Oct 2 protest, says she didn't talk of complete liquor ban

Senior BJP leader and former chief minister of Madhya Pradesh Uma Bharti said here on Friday she never talked of complete liquor prohibition in the state. She was talking to media persons at her residence here.

Uma Bharti who has been demanding prohibition in Madhya Pradesh for several months now and confronted the government on this said she never said there should be complete prohibition in Madhya Pradesh.

"When I didn't talk of complete prohibition when I was CM, how could I talk of the same now," she said. "I am opposed to Ahata culture. I want regulation in sale of liquor in such a way that people buy the

liquor from a shop and go back home to drink it over there. I am sure this would minimize the liquor consumption in society considerably," she added.

Attacking the Ahata culture she said it was ironical that on one hand the government had penalized drunken driving but on the other hand it allowed drinking in ahatas. "Do those having liquor in ahatas go home in helicopters?" she asked.

However, she said, she was happy that Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan was also in favour of regulated sale of liquor and he started working in the direction. Hence, she had decided to cancel the October 2 convention of women. Rather, she added, a maximum 500 women would gather in the state capital and would march from Kali Mandir to Lily Talkies square.

Uma Bharti, who had decided not to contest 2019 Lok Sabha polls, parried the question when asked if she was willing to contest the next LS or state Assembly election and whether she would like to contest from Uttar Pradesh or Madhya Pradesh. She said she had already answered the question earlier and she would not like to repeat it.

# Cheetahs from Namibia to fly via Jaipur to Kuno

Preparations under the cheetah translocation project are in full swing at Kuno Palpur Sanctuary, Sheopur. Forest department has deployed three best known veterinarians in the wildlife Sanctuary where at least eight Namibian Cheetahs will be released in specially built enclosure in presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi on his birthday i.e on September 17.

Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (Wild Life) JS Chauhan said the Cheetahs will be brought by plane from Namibia to Jaipur and from there to Kuno Palpur Sanctuary by a chopper on the day.

Meanwhile, the state forest officers are upbeat about the recent visit of the South Africa team to Kuno Palpur Sanctuary, in Sheopur. The team was satisfied by the arrangements being made at the sanctuary under Cheetah translocation project, said the officials.

A senior forest officer said the team saw the quarantine area and enclosure made for Cheetahs. One single enclosure is 5 square km and inside it, there are nine compartments.

The team has also given some tips and suggestions

to the forest officers and the same will be executed in the coming days. Dean of Wild Life Institute, Dehradun, Dr YV Jhala while talking to Free Press said the South Africa team was quiet positive, they inspected the habitat, prey base etc and were satisfied by the arrangements. Notably, the Indian government is yet to link an agreement with South Africa for translocation of Cheetahs. The South Africa government will decide over the matter once its team which visited Kuno Palpur Sanctuary submits its report.

# HC asks UP police to investigate Arya Samaj's role in conversion for marriage

Termining approval of Arya Samaj for conversion of a Muslim girl to Hindu religion as illegal, the Gwalior bench of Madhya Pradesh High Court has ordered Ghaziabad (Uttar Pradesh) Senior Superintendent of Police to investigate the matter. The court also found that the issuance of conversion

certificate by Arya Samaj was in violation of Section 5 of Madhya Pradesh Dharma Swatantrya Adhiniyam, 1968. The court stated that Arya Samaj was empowered only to perform wedding rituals according to Hindu rites and not to solemnise them and issue marriage certificates. The order was issued by a division bench of Justices Rohit Arya and Milind Ramesh Phadke

against Arya Samaj Vivah Trust. The HC also ordered for verification of existence, constitution and members of the Trust, if any, and whether they were involved in alleged activities. The court ordered corrective measures to be taken as per law.

The HC bench also observed that the activities of Vivah Trust tantamount to running marriage shops. It is a serious threat to sanctity attached to marriages recognised under personal laws, particularly the Hindu Marriage Act, the

judges opined. The court was hearing a habeas corpus plea filed by Shivpuri district resident Rahul in 2021 praying for the release of his wife Hina Khan who was illegally confined by police authorities in a women's shelter home in Gwalior.

The petitioner claimed that they married after running away and his wife, a Muslim, converted to Hinduism. He submitted a conversion certificate and marriage certificate issued on September 17, 2019, by Arya Samaj Vivah Trust in Ghaziabad.
