Not Mandal but a commission for backward classes

Modi government's slogan of 'sabka saath, sabka vikas' is just not a political slogan but the government is actually working for the uplift of all strata of the society, including the feeble, elder people, the backwards and those with physical disabilities.

Speaking to Free Press after a media interaction. Thawarchand Gehlot, Union minister for social justice and empowerment said that for the first time his government was trying to give Constitutional cover to the large section of backward classes in the country through the proposed National Commission for Backward Classes. "The new National Commission for Backward Classes will repeal the existing National Backward Class Commission because it does not have the powers of listen-OBCs", he said.


It was in 1953 that Kaka Kalelkar Commission had been formed by Pt Jawaharlal Nehru and later in 1978,

the Janata government had formed the Mandal Commission under Article 340 for looking into the conditions of socially and educationally backward classes. But VP Singh implemented the Mandal Commission recommendations and eventually lost his government in the unending political fire that was sparked

off following the implementation by his government. Mandal commission was wound up in 1980 but Singh had reopened it in 1989, only to dig his own grave. Gehlot stayed clear of any controversy and said that the new commission was meant only for the betterment and for redressing the grievances and complaints ing to the grievances of of other backward classes as the new body would have powers of a Civil Court for this purpose. Commission but not satisfactorily, he said, adding a Parliamentary Committee too had recommended it

Known to be close to the PM and said to be in the race for a promotion in the next few weeks, Gehlot told media persons that his ministry was also trying to look after the well-being of over 11 crore elder people through various schemes, besides for the sanitation workers with additional financial support since the last three years.

However, what is political-

ly significant is the creation of a new commission for backward classes which were said to be voters of either a regional outfit like BSP or at national level, with the Congress for many years but weaned away by the BJP slowly.

The country already has a commission dealing with the scheduled castes (under Article 338 of the Constitution) and another one for the scheduled tribes (under article 338 A) and now the BJP, in its efforts to reach out to all the sections of the society, has proposed Constitutional amendment for the backward classes.

The cabinet minister said that while last month the two bills related to the proposed national commission had been passed by the Lok Sabha, the Rajva Sabha had sent it to select committee for further examination but he hoped soon it would be

ratified by the Upper House and the commission would be constituted.

Though he tried to underplay its political benefits, Gehlot said that the country had many castes covered under the backward classes and it was Prime Minister Modi's concern that socially and educationally backward classes be protected by Constitution

and thus the bills had been moved in the Parliament. The existing NCBC was constituted in 1993 in pursuance of the Supreme Court's judgement and directions in the Indra Sawhney case but it had a limited function of recommending to the Union Government

the inclusion and exclusion of castes and communities in central list of OBCs and therefore it was of no great use for the OBCs.

Gehlot said that as a Constitutional entity, the pro-

posed backward classes commission, once formed, would do a lot of good for the under privileged people across the country with state governments who will also have a greater say in notifying castes and communities in the central List.

NGT slams Haryana govt over dumping of waste in Aravallis

Cow vigilantism, hate crimes show state in

New Delhi: The National Green Tribunal on Tuesday slammed the Haryana government and its civic bodies over disposal of industrial waste and construction debris in the Aravalli forests on the Gurgaon-Faridabad road.

"Aravalli hill is a forest area. How can you make it a dumping site? How could you allow the leachate to accumulate at Bandhwari sewage treatment plant?

"We had asked you to take action. Why don't you do something? Let there be some constructive suggestion," a bench headed by NGT Chairperson Justice Swatanter Kumar said while directing the official concerned from the municipal corporation to be present before it. The observations came after several residents from nearby villages appeared before the tribunal and alleged water contamination in their area.

They told the NGT that continued dumping of waste at the Bandhwari landfill site had led a stream of dirty black water or leachate into the Aravalli forest, polluting the aquifers around both Delhi and Gurgaon.

Conspiracy charges framed...

All six were granted bail by CBI special judge S K Yadav on a personal bond of Rs 50,000 each after rejecting the CBI's opposition to their bail plea. The court will resume hearing on Wednesday.

The accused, who spent nearly three hours in the court, had sought discharge for the offence of criminal conspiracy, which the judge rejected. The charge of conspiracy is in addition to the existing charges against them for promoting enmity between different groups on grounds of religion for which they are already facing trial. The apex court had while restoring the charge of criminal conspiracy, directed clubbing of two cases relating to the demolition. The court had also ordered that the trial be concluded ed in two years. Besides the six, conspiracy charges were also framed against Ramvilas Vedanti, Baikunth Lal Sharma, Champat Rai Bansal, Mahant Nritya Gopaldas, Dharam Das and Satish Pradhan -- all of whom were allegedly present when the 16th-century structure in Ayodhya was pulled down on December 6, 1992.

The counsel for the accused argued against the framing of charges and pleaded not guilty, saying they had no role in the razing of the mosque. The accused were asked to appear before the court for framing of charges in the light of the Supreme Court order last month. After Advani, Joshi and Bharti failed to turn up on May 25 and 26, the special court had said no further application for an adjournment or exemption from personal appearance would be entertained. The court had on May 26 fixed the hearing for Tuesday. The Supreme Court had called the destruction of the mosque a "crime" which shook the "secular fabric of the Constitution" while allowing the CBI's plea seeking restoration of the criminal conspiracy charge against Advani and others. The CBI had charge-sheeted 21 people in the case. Many of them, including Shiv Sena supremo Bal Thackeray and the VHP's Acharya Giriraj Kishore, Ashok Singhal, Paramhans Ram Chandra Das and Mahant Avaidhynath, have since died. They were all named in an FIR for allegedly instigating a mob which climbed atop the mosque and tore it down, triggering large-scale communal clashes across the country which left hundreds dead and many more wounded. - PTI
