

PARIS: The iconic Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, which was badly damaged in a fire in April 2019, will be rebuilt on schedule, French President Emmanuel Macron said on Thursday. "The commitment for 2024 will be kept," dpa news agency quoted the President as saying to the Le Parisien - Aujourd'hui en France newspaper. Exactly two years ago, on April 15, 2019, the world-famous landmark in the heart of Paris went up in flames.



Europe has surpassed 1 mn C-19 deaths: WHO

A top official from the World Health Organisation says Europe has surpassed 1 million deaths from COVID-19 and the situation remains "serious," with about 1.6 million new cases reported each week in the region. Addressing recent concerns about vaccines, Dr Hans Kluge also said the risk of people suffering blood clots is far higher for people with COVID-19 than people who receive AstraZeneca's coronavirus vaccine.

Speaking to reporters during a visit to Greece, Kluge did point to "early signs that transmission may be slowing across several countries" and cited "declining incidence" among the oldest people.

He said the proportion of COVID-19 deaths among people over 80, who have been prioritized for vaccines, had dropped to nearly 30% - the lowest level in the pandemic.

"For now, the risk of suffering blood clots is much higher for someone with COVID-19 than for someone who has taken the AstraZeneca vaccine," he said.

UKRAINE SEEKS MORE SUPPORT

Ukraine's top diplomat asked Thursday for stronger Western backing, saying "words of support aren't enough" amid escalating tensions in the country's east and a Russian troop buildup across the border.

Ukrainian Foreign Minister Dmytro Kuleba, speaking after talks with his counterparts from Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, asked the Baltic nations to reach out to other European Union and NATO members about offering "practical assistance" to Kyiv.

More than 14,000 people have died in seven years of fighting between Ukrainian forces and Russia-backed separatists in eastern Ukraine that erupted after Russia's 2014 annexation of Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula. Efforts to reach a political settlement have stalled and violations of a shaky truce have become increasingly frequent in recent weeks.

Ukraine and the West also have sounded alarms about the concentration of troops along Russia's western border, a buildup that the US and NATO have described as the largest since 2014.

Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelenskyy is heading Friday to Paris to discuss the tensions with French President Emmanuel Macron. Russia has argued that it's free to deploy its forces wherever it deems necessary on its territory.

The Russian defense minister charged earlier this week that the buildup was a response to security threats posed by NATO forces near Russia's borders.

Russia's Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova on Thursday dismissed Western concerns about the Russian troop buildup as a "propaganda campaign" and urged the West to encourage Kyiv to de-escalate tensions in the east.

Kremlin officials have warned Ukraine against trying to use force to reclaim control of the rebel east, saying that Russia may intervene to protect Russian civilians in the region. Amid the recent tensions, the United States informed Turkey that two US warships would sail to the Black Sea on April 14 and April 15 and stay there until for about three weeks. But Turkish Foreign Minister Mevlut Cavusoglu said Thursday that the US Embassy had notified Ankara that the two warships wouldn't be making the crossing. The US Navy ships have made regular visits to the Black Sea in past years, vexing Moscow. Earlier this week, a senior Russian diplomat described the planned US ships' deployment to the Black Sea as "openly provocative."

The three Baltic nations said Thursday's visit by their top diplomats to Kyiv was intended to show support for Ukraine and send a warning message to Russia. "This visit is intended to show that we stand in solidarity with Ukraine (and) strongly support this country and its right to self-defense," said Lithuanian Foreign Minister Gabrielius Landsbergis, adding that it was also to "demonstrate to Russia that further provocative actions can have consequences."

At least four policemen were killed during the clashes as violence erupted across Pakistan over demand of the expulsion of a French envoy over the publication of alleged blasphemous caricatures of the Prophet Muhammad, according to media reports.

The police also used baton-charge on the demonstrators. Violence erupted across Pakistan after security forces fired bullets and tear gas shells on protesters as the country has been facing civil unrest. The situation turned volatile after the arrest of Tehreek-e-Labbaik Pakistan (TLP) Chief Saad Hussain Rizvi on April 12 in Lahore. Reports indicate that over two dozen TLP activists have been killed in police firing during the clashes.

Interior Minister of Pakistan, Sheikh Rashid on Wednesday announced that the government has decided to ban the Tehreek-e-Labbaik Pakistan, whose supporters and workers have been carrying out violent protests across the country for three days after the arrest of their chief. TLP is a hardline religious group with a massive following across Pakistan. According to Geo News, the police on Wednesday arrested 120 people, belonging to a religious organisation, for staging a protest, creating chaos in the city, and resorting to violence. According to a police spokesperson, 30 people were taken into custody from the city's South Zone, 60 from the East Zone, while 47 demonstrators were arrested from Karachi's West Zone. According to the Pakistani



media, the French Embassy in Pakistan on Thursday advised all French nationals and companies to temporarily leave the country, after violent anti-France protests paralysed large parts of the country this week. TLP has been demanding expulsion of the French ambassador from Pakistan over the publication of 'blasphemous caricatures' in the Charlie Hebdo magazine and remarks about Islam and terrorism by French President Emmanuel Macron. According to media reports, the Imran Khan-led Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf government signed an agreement with the TLP in November last agreeing to expel the French Ambassador. The TLP launched a massive protest in November last year against the cartoons but dispersed after the agreement with the government by February. The deal was extended until April 20.

Drink a glass of treated Fukushima water: China to Japan Deputy PM

China has asked Japanese Deputy Prime Minister Taro Aso to drink treated radioactive water from Fukushima to prove his claim that it is safe to drink.

The comments came as Tokyo said it will release water from the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant into the Pacific Ocean in two years.

The accumulating water has been stored in tanks at the plant since 2011, when a massive earthquake and tsunami damaged its reactors and their cooling water became contaminated and began leaking.

"A Japanese official said it is okay if we drink this water, so then please drink it," Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian said at a press conference on

Wednesday. During the event, Zhao described what he saw as Japan's ignorance of the ecological environment as 'totally unjustifiable'.

On Tuesday, Japan announced plans to release the

water into the sea. The controversial decision came after more than seven years of discussion on what to do with the water. The plant's storage capacity will be reached late next year. At a

press conference on Tuesday. Aso said I have heard that we will have no harm if we drink' the water.

At the Chinese press conference on Wednesday, Zhao urged the Japanese government 'not to forget the historical tragedy' of thousands of people who became affected by what is now known as Minamata disease.

The condition, which paralyzes the central nervous system and produces birth defects, was caused by mercury-tainted water that was dumped into the sea by a Chisso Corp chemical plant in southwestern Japan from 1932 to 1968. Japan's Minamata disease happened not far away and the pain of the local victims has yet to be healed, Zhao said.

Senior royals to skip uniforms at Prince Philip's funeral

Senior royals must wear civilian clothes to Prince Philip's funeral, defusing potential tensions over who would be allowed to don military uniforms.

Queen Elizabeth II's decision means Prince Harry won't risk being the only member of the royal family not in uniform during Saturday's funeral for his grandfather, who died last week at the age of 99.

Members of the royal family often wear uniforms to public events by virtue of their honorary roles with the British Army, Royal Navy and Royal Air Force. But Harry lost his honorary military titles when he decided to give up frontline royal duties last year. As a result, protocol suggests that Harry, an army veteran who served two tours of duty in

Afghanistan, may only wear a suit with medals at royal functions, Britain's Press Association reported.

The decision also sidesteps another potential controversy after reports that Prince Andrew considered wearing an admi-

ral's uniform to his father's funeral. Andrew retains his military titles even though he was forced to step away from royal duties after a disastrous interview with the BBC about his acquaintance with convicted sex offender Jeffrey Epstein.

Canadian lawmaker caught naked during video conference

OTTAWA: A Canadian Parliament member was caught stark naked in a virtual meeting of the House of Commons. William Amos, who has represented the Quebec district of Pontiac since 2015,

appeared on the screens of his fellow lawmakers completely naked Wednesday. The pandemic has meant many Canadian lawmakers participate in sessions via video conference instead of in person.

Pak PM, cabinet approve ban on TLP

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan has blacklisted radical Islamist Tehreek-i-Labbaik Pakistan (TLP), whose supporters and workers have been carrying out violent protests across the country for three days after the arrest of their chief.

Prime Minister Imran Khan and the federal cabinet approved a summary on Thursday from the interior ministry seeking a ban on the TLP under the anti-terrorism law, Geo News reported.

On Wednesday, Interior Minister of Pakistan, Sheikh Rashid Ahmed, announced that the religious-political outfit would be banned under Rule 11(b) of the Anti-Terrorism Act (ATA), 1997.

Rashid said the Punjab province government had recommended a ban on the organisation, for which a summary was sent to the federal

cabinet. He said TLP leaders used to come to all rounds of talks with the government after issuing instructions to their workers regarding road closures.

"They were more prepared than us but today we have decided that [a] ban on TLP [will be placed] and this file is going to the cabinet for the approval from today," the minister said.

After the summary was approved on Thursday, the cabinet has started work issuing the declaration of the TLP's ban. The government will present the declaration of the ban in the Supreme Court, said sources.

The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) will subsequently denotify the TLP on orders of the apex court. Sources told Geo News all

parliamentarians of the TLP will be automatically disqualified after the ECP denotifies the party.

The TLP is protesting against the arrest of their leader Saad Hussain Rizvi, who was taken into custody earlier this week, and blasphemous caricatures published in France. The protests have turned violent and several casualties have also been reported.

The demonstrators have demanded that the French ambassador be sent home and import of goods from that country banned, as reported by Dawn.

Congressional resolution introduced to honour Babasaheb Ambedkar

An Indian-American Congressman has introduced a resolution in the US House of Representatives for a second consecutive year to honour Bhimrao Ambedkar, the architect of India's Constitution, on his 130th birth anniversary so that young leaders around the world can be inspired by his vision for equality.



India is celebrating the 130th birth anniversary of Ambedkar this year. "Ambedkar stood for an India and America where we respect the dignity of all," Indian-American Democratic Congressman Ro Khanna said in a tweet after introducing the legislation in the US House of Representatives on Wednesday.

"Today, I'm reintroducing my resolution to honour B R Ambedkar, in the hopes that young leaders around the world will read his work and be inspired by his vision for equality," he said.

Introduced by Khanna for the second consecutive year, the resolution acknowledges the profound impact of America's discriminatory practices, specifically the systematic discrimination of African-Americans and women in the United States, as influential in his pursuit to guarantee equal rights for every human being in the Indian Constitution. Honouring the accomplishments of Ambedkar

and the impact of his legacy on the Constitution of India and jurisprudence around the world; the resolution affirms the prohibition of untouchability and caste discrimination in all forms, as enshrined in the principles in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Recognising that equality, justice and liberty are essential rights for all people, the resolution says that Dr Ambedkar's contributions to economics, political science, civil rights, religious harmony, and jurisprudence have had a profound impact around the world, promoting democratic values, unfettered equality, and justice for peoples of all castes, races, genders, religions, and backgrounds.

The resolution notes that former US president Barack Obama invoked Ambedkar's contribution to the Indian Constitution and society in an address before the Indian parliament in 2010.

Sydney man finds snake in lettuce bought at supermarket

CANBERRA: Alex White thought he was watching a huge worm writhing in a plastic-wrapped lettuce he'd just brought home from a Sydney supermarket - until a snake tongue flicked.



"I kind of completely freaked out when I saw this little tongue come out of its mouth and start flicking around and realized it was a snake because worms don't have tongues," White said on Thursday.

"I definitely kind of panicked a bit," he added.

It was a venomous pale-headed snake that authorities say made an 870-kilometre (540-mile) journey to Sydney from a Toowoomba packing plant wrapped in plastic with a pair of cos lettuce.

The refrigerated supermarket supply chain likely lulled the cold-blooded juvenile into a stupor until White bought the lettuce at an inner-city ALDI supermarket on Monday evening and rode his bicycle home with salad and snake in his backpack.

White and his partner Amelia Neate spotted the snake moving as soon as the lettuce were unpacked on to the kitchen table. They also noticed the plastic wrapping was torn and that the snake could escape, so they quickly stuffed the reptile with the lettuce into a plastic food storage container.

White phoned the WIRES rescue organization and a snake handler took the snake away that night. Before the handler arrived, White said WIRES had explained to him: "If you get bitten, you've got to go to hospital really quickly." ALDI is investigating how a snake could have found its way into a supermarket.
