Raje made the remarks while addressing a gathering on Dalit icon B R Ambedkar's 127th birth anniversary here.

The chief minister said, "a few people are trying to create confusion on the reservation system. It has not been abolished and it will never happen."

"We will not let the reservation be abolished ever. The government is committed to secure the benefits of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes," she said.

She said Dr Ambedkar dedicated his life for equal rights and eliminated discrimination and ill-practices prevailing in the society. "We are working on the path shown by him and progressing by taking everyone along in the state. The state government has increased loan subsidy from Rs 5 lakh to Rs 10 lakh for youths of the SC/ST community for setting-up industry. In manufacturing sector, the government now provides loan of Rs 25 lakh instead of Rs

The chief minister said if any industry employs over 15 per cent bonafide SC/ST residents of the state, a maximum of Rs 85,000 annually per individual will be given as an employment subsidy. Raje also announced equal application fees for all category candidates having Rs 2.50 lakh annual family income applying for government jobs.

Seeking to give shape to the government's concept of 'one nation, one election', a Law Commission internal working paper has recommended holding simultaneous election to the Lok Sabha and state assemblies in two phases begin-

The second phase of simultaneous polls can take place in 2024, the document states. The document has proposed amending the Constitution and the Representation of the People Act to shorten or extend the terms of state legislative assemblies to effect the move.

The amendments are in line with the ones recommended by a parliamentary panel and the NITI Aayog.

The states which are recommended to be covered under phase I are where assembly polls are due in 2021. These include Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.

States which will come under phase II are Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Delhi and Punjab. To hold elections in these states along with Lok Sabha polls, the terms of the assemblies have to be extended.

Based on a suggestion made by the Election Commission, the working paper also says that a no-confidence motion against the government should be followed by a confidence motion. This would ensure that if the opposition does not have numbers to form an alternative government, the regime in office cannot be removed.

Udhampur: As the Bakerwals make their way to the upper reaches of Jammu and Kashmir with their belongings, she trudges along burdened by the weight of her eight-year-old daughter's death. "My only wish is the culprits should be hanged for the heinous crime, so that no other family has to go through it," she says.

Set up fast track court, CM to CJ

hief Minister Mehbooba Mufti has written to the chief justice of |ammu and Kashmir High Court, requesting setting up of a special fast track court to try the brutal rape and murder of an eight-year-old girl in Kathua. The chief minister requested the chief justice for establishment of the special fast track court for the case, official sources said. It would complete trial in 90 days and would be the first such court in state, they said. The government has also decided to terminate from service the cops accused in the case, they added.

### Cong seeks Yogi removal...

He pointed out that the High Court has put on record that "The disturbing feature of the case is that law and order machinery and the government officials were directly in league and under the influence of Kuldeep Singh," noting that the police did not take down his name, nor allowed the victim make any allegations against him and did not register her complaint

On the Advocate General's insensitive stand that no accused can be arrested without the investigating officer (IO) following the procedure and collecting evidence in support of allegations of rape, the High Court dubbed his approach as "not only appalling but shocks the conscience of the court in the backdrop of the instant case... The prosecutrix (victim) and her family members have been running from pillar to post but her

complaint was not registered, despite approaching the CM." The High Court even questioned "The bona fides of police authorities at the highest level" from the way the advocate general "vehemently and categorically stated that the IO will not arrest accused Kuldeep Singh until statements under Section 161/164 CRPC are recorded."

Ordering the arrest, the Court said, "Arrest of accused in the present case is necessarily required to safeguard the majesty of law and dignity of the prosecutrix and to instil confidence that free, fair investigation shall be undertaken by the investigating agency."

## India asks all parties to

NEW DELHI: As the US, the UK and France launched air strikes in Syria targeting chemical weapons facilities, India on Saturday urged all parties concerned to show restraint and avoid any further escalation in the war-torn country.

The External Affairs Ministry said India has taken note of the air strikes in Syria and was closely following the situation. "We have taken note of the recent strikes in Syria. India is closely following the situation. The alleged use of chemical weapons, if true, is deplorable. We call for an impartial and objective investigation by the OPCW (Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons) to establish the facts," Spokesperson in the External Affairs Ministry Raveesh Kumar said.

## We need to revisit our Constitution, laws: Minister

**AGENCIES** New Delhi

Union Minister of State for Human Resource Development (HRD) Satypal Singh on Saturday said that the country's Constitution and laws need to be revisited if "justice for all" is to be ensured.

Speaking on "Rule of Law" on the occasion of BR Ambedkar's birth anniversary at the Delhi University (DU), the Minister remarked that in past decades, the country's Constitution had been interpreted so there was a need to revisit it.

"In the last about two decades, the way the

Constitution has been interpreted and the laws have been interpreted... Let us revisit our laws. Let revisit us Constitution."

The Minister also raised doubts over the way secular aspect of the Constitution has played out and hinted that there was an imbalance in the way the law treats minorities and majority.

"We want this country to be secular country... The kind of freedom has been given to the minorities... Minorities have the right to run their institutes. their religious institutions, but the majority does not have. Law is equal to all," he said.

Singh remarked on the inequities in society, saying that "one who steals Rs 100 and one who swindles Rs 100 crore, deserve the punishment" same according to the book of law.

"Does it really do justice to society?" he said.

Despite the Right to Education, he said, millions of students did not go to schools because the "law doesn't have teeth". "Law, life and death spare

no one... We need to do a lot to realise the dreams of Ambedkar," he added. DU Vice Chancellor
