Car sales escalate, courtesy CM Baghel's policies

More cars have been sold in the state in January 2021 as compared to January 2020.

In January last year, 4523 cars were sold. However, the figure in the corresponding period this year is 4644 cars. This number is more than the number of 4233 cars sold in the month of December last year, a government press release said on Tuesday. The automobile sector of the state as well as other sectors have registered a steady growth due to the schemes implemented by the state government under the leadership of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel focusing on strengthening the rural economy and increasing the income of farmers and forest dwellers. The record procurement of 93 lakh metric tonnes of paddy on minimum support price (MSP) along with the benefits of Rajiv Gandhi Kisan Nyay Yojana, 19 lakh farmers were benefited by the transfer of Rs. 5750 crore.

No new Covid-19 deaths in 7 states/UTs in 3 weeks: Govt

NEW DELHI: Seven states and UTs have reported no new Covid-19 deaths in the last three weeks, while 15 have not registered any fatality in the past 24 hours, the Centre said on Tuesday, underlining that consistent gains are being made in terms of declining new cases and causalities. The Centre, however, noted that the last national sero survey findings have shown that over 70 per cent of the population is still susceptible to the disease. The seven states and UTs -- Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Mizoram, Nagaland and Lakshadweep -- have reported no new Covid-19 deaths in last three weeks, Union Health Secretary Rajesh Bhushan said.

Kerala recorded 5,214 Covid-19 cases on Tuesday, pushing the caseload to 9,77,394, while the toll mounted to 3,902 with 19 additional fatalities. Addressing a press briefing, he said India was the fastest country to reach 6 million vaccination doses of Covid-19 in 24 days. Bhushan said within the country also some states have performed well, while others need to improve their vaccination coverage.

SC stays arrest of Tharoor, Sardesai, others for sharing 'unconfirmed' news

The Supreme Court on Tuesday stayed the arrest of Congress leader Shashi Tharoor, veteran journalist Rajdeep Sardesai, and others, who challenged the registration of multiple FIRs against them for allegedly sharing certain unconfirmed news on the death of one of the protestors, during the Kisan tractor rally on Republic Day.

Kapil Sibal, senior lawyer appearing for Tharoor and Sardesai, sought an immediate stay on the arrest of his clients and said, "Mylords, I seek immediate relief in the case." "We stay the arrest till we hear the matter further," the bench, comprising of Chief Justice Sharad Arvind Bobde, Justices AS Bopanna and V Ramasubramanian, said. The apex court also issued a notice to the

UP govt to table love jihad bill in Budget session

Even as PILs are pending at the Allahabad High Court, the Yogi Adityanath govt may table the Uttar Pradesh Prohibition of Unlawful Religious Conversion Ordinance, 2020 to enact a law during the forthcoming budget session of the State Legislature, beginning February 18.

The Yogi Cabinet on Tuesday cleared the UP Prohibition of Unlawful Religious Conversion Act, 2021 after making an amendment.

UP was the first to pass an Ordinance on November 24 2020 to make a law against love-jihad by passing the Uttar Pradesh Prohibition of Unlawful Religious Conversion Ordinance 2020.

Yogi govt to present its last, largest populist budget

LUCKNOW: The Yogi Adityanath govt will present its last but largest-ever populist and first-ever paperless budget of Uttar Pradesh on February 22 to dole out sops for farmers, women and youth with a focus on the Assembly elections due in first quarter of 2022. The State Finance Minister Suresh Khanna said that the budget is likely to be near Rs 5.5 to 5.6 lakh crore. It will be the largest-ever budget by any government in the state. Last year, the Yogi government had presented a budget of over Rs 5.12 lakh crores. The finance minister hinted that the Legislators' Fund (Vidhayak Nidhi), which was increased from Rs 2 to 3 cr last financial year but was withheld due to Covid-19, will be released in the current budget,


