Youth hacked to death in closed room at Abhishek Nagar

Naked body of a young man was found in a pool of blood in his locked house on Monday evening. He was identified as Krishnpal Singh Rathore of Nankheda, who lived in house number 2/2 of Abhishek Nagar. There were more than a dozen stab marks on the body and the police suspect that he was killed 12 to 24 hours ago. Krishnpal was a miscreant and was involved in property dealing. A year-and-a-half ago, he opened an office at C-21 Mall opposite Nanakheda Bus Stand. He had bullied his way

into the house where his body was recovered. Krishnpal was last seen in Abhishek Nagar on Sunday night. The house in Abhishek Nagar was occupied by Madhu Jain till one-and-a-half year ago. Her daughter Manisha and Krishnpal were friends. They drove Madhu out and later Krishnpal drove away Manisha too. Currently, he had keys of the house in question and was trying to sell it. He was currently residing in Preeganj area with his aunt. When he did not reach his home on Monday

evening, his family started searching. ASP Amrendra Singh Chouhan said that Salman Lala had informed police about missing Krishnpal. The police then went to the house at Abhishek Nagar and recovered the body after breaking the main door. PSL officer Preeti Gaikwad said that the body was 12 to 24 hours old implying that Krishnpal was killed between 12 and 4 o'clock on Sunday night. A sky-coloured woman purse along with cooked food brought from restaurant was also recovered indicating that some-

one was present with Krishnpal in the house. Gold chain and rings of Krishnpal were also missing. Police have detained some friends of Krishnpal. Preliminary investigation indicated that the killer was not in a hurry. The killer had food with Krishnpal before killing him. After the murder, killer locked the house and walked away. Police said that killer was known to Krishnpal. They said that naked body indicated towards illegal relationship. SP Satyendra Shukla said that some leads were received after inspecting the spot. On that basis, they would soon be able to arrest the killer.

COVID-19 DISTRICT UPDATE

Six new cases take corona tally to 5,202

Six new cases took the number of corona cases in the district to 5,202 on Sunday. Toll remained at 103 as no new death was reported during the day. As per medical bulletin issued at 11 pm, out of 177 sample reports, five from Ujjain City and one from Nagda returned Corona positive. Two of them were women. Overall 50 patients, 21 of them symptomatic, are under treatment. Samples of 1, 69, 595 people have been taken across the district so far and no report is awaited. With one more patient discharged on the day, the number of discharged patients remained on to 5,049.

Speed up construction projects: Comm tells officers

NOTES: (1) The National Company Law Tribunal ("NCLT") Indore Bench at Ahmedabad vide order dated 17th September 2020 (Insolvency Commencement Date) has initiated Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process ("CIRP") u/s 9 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 ("The Code") based on the application filed by an operational creditor of the Company, Mr. Navin Khandelwal IP No. IBB/PA-001/IP-P00703/2017-18/11301 was appointed as an Interim Resolution Professional ("IRP") to manage affairs of the Company in accordance with the provision of Code. Pursuant to the NCLT order for commencement of the CIRP and in line with the provision of the Code, the power of the Board of Directors stand suspended and be exercised by the IRP. Subsequently, Mr. Navin Kumar Sood IP No. IBB/PA-001/IP-P00132/2017-18/10274 (IP) of Mr. Navin Khandelwal IP No. IBB/PA-001/IP-P00703/2017 has been appointed as RP vide NCLT order no. IA/12(IND)/2021 in CP(IB) 9 of 2020 dated 28th January, 2021. Therefore the above results were reviewed by the Management and the IRP. These standalone financial results for the nine months ended 31st December 2020 have been prepared by the management of the Company in accordance with Regulation 33(2) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Rules, 2015. These unaudited financial results were placed before the RP on 12th February 2021 for their consideration. Accordingly, the unaudited financial results were considered and recommended in the meeting. In the view thereof, the RP in reliance of such representations, clarification and explanation provided by the Management has approved the same. To the extent, these unaudited financial results indicate or confirm of events prior to the appointment of the Resolution Professional i.e CIRP commencement date, the confirmation is being provided by the Management. The resolution professional is relying on the management representation for all information and confirmation in relation to the day to day functioning of the Company. The RP has approved these unaudited financial results only to the limited extent of discharging the powers of the Board of Directors of the company (suspended during CIRP) which has been conferred upon him in terms of provisions of Section 17 of the Code. (2) In accordance with the Code, public announcement was made calling the financial and operational creditors of the Company to submit their claims with RP. Accordingly, RP will collate the claims submitted by the creditors and reconcile the same with the accounts. To the extent the process for submission and reconciliation of the claims is an on-going process, no accounting impact in the books of accounts has been made in recent of excess, short or non-receipt of claims for operational and financial creditors. (3) The carrying value of property plant and equipment and intangible as at 31st December, 2020 is Rs. 15,036.69 lacs and 12.06 lacs respectively. As explained in note 1 above, the Company is under CIRP and RP is required to invite submission of resolution plans from potential resolution applicants, which shall be put up for necessary approvals before the Committee of Creditors ("CoC") and the NCLT. The CIRP is not yet concluded and hence, the final outcome is not known. The Company has not taken in consideration any impact on the value of the asset, if any, in preparation Financial Results as required by IND AS 10 on "Event after the Reporting Period". The Company has not made full assessment of impairment as required by IND AS 36 on Impairment of Assets, if any as at 31st December, 2020 in the value of property plant and equipment and intangible asset. (4) The SARS-CoV-2 virus responsible for COVID-19 outbreak, which has been declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organization, continues to spread across the globe and India and has contributed to a significant decline in economic activities and severely impacted the business and operations of the Company. The extent to which the COVID-19 pandemic will impact the Company's results will depend on future developments, which are highly uncertain. The Company has assessed the possible effects that may arise from the COVID-19 pandemic on the business. As on the current date, based on the assessment, the Company has concluded that the impact of COVID-19 pandemic is not material on the carrying value of the assets of the business, however this has effected the operations of the company and has had impact on sales and profitability among others. As Covid - 19 is unprecedented and the full recovery is still not in sight thus the exact effect of Covid - 19 on company financials can't be ascertained now. (5) Renewable Energy Certificates of Rs. 1173 Lacs is subject to adjudication of pending litigation at Apex Court the management is hopeful of realising the amount considering the legal opinion. (6) Service Tax matter related to Valuation method for calculation of Service tax is pending with Commissioner Central Excise & CGST Indore and approx demand in show cause is Rs. 4.680 Lacs. (7) The Company has allotted 249,000 equity shares on 24th July, 2020 under Ujaas ESOP 2015 to the option grantees, who exercised the options granted under the said scheme. The said shares got listed on NSE and ESE on 18th September, 2020. (8) Figures of the previous periods have been regrouped and reclassified where ever necessary and feasible, in order to make them comparable.
